The Grace operating results for the 1st six months of 2023 approximate the dected not loss, with

budgeted net loss, with a shortfall in Revenues substantially offset by favorable changes in operating expenses. The favorable operating expenses are primarily due to timing of expenses and are expected to be offset during the second half of the year. The primary reason for the revenue shortfall is in receipt of Pledge payments. Grace parishioners have an excellent history of meeting their pledge,


