
Advent 2023

It is baptism where all ministry begins and where the Church has its birth

"Baptism is full initiation by water and the Holy Spirit into Christ's Body the Church." (BCP, pg. 298) In the waters of baptism we are grafted to the Body of Christ, and we share in the priesthood of Jesus. Baptism is a moment of true conversion, when a new identity is received, and Christ's Body takes on new flesh. It is baptism, not ordination, where all ministry begins and where the Church has its birth. The Catechism lists "the baptized" as first among the ministers of the Church.

In order to express more fully the place of importance of baptism in the life of the Church, our baptismal font has been moved to a place of honor and prominence. Thus, we are confronted with the centrality of baptism every time we gather for worship, and the assembly is able to encircle each baptismal candidate as they receive the Sacrament of New Birth. In addition, our friends who worship with us via Live-Stream, are able to see and experience the celebration of baptism more clearly.

Our font did not always reside in its former home. (Thank you, Dr. Suzanne Bowles, Church Historian, for helping us understand the likely changes in font location in our space over the years!) Rather, at one time the font was in back of the room and was moved as the nave expanded. So, this is not the first time our font has made a journey in our space.



We thank you, Father, for the water of Baptism. In it we are buried with Christ in his death. By it we share in his resurrection. Through it we are reborn by the Holy Spirit. Therefore in joyful obedience to your Son, we bring into his fellowship those who come to him in faith, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Our font is beautiful and dear to us. Solid marble and coming in at just under 1,000 pounds, any move had to be made carefully and thoughtfully. We were blessed by the skill and care of John McManus who, together with engineers, ensured the safe transfer of our sacred font. Nancy Dougherty, of Studio 1200, designed the flooring that would enthrone the font in its new location. And the project was funded by a very generous gift from

Bruce Rudin, made in loving memory of our cherished Dora Monserrate, whose own baptism was a blessing to us, and who celebrated every baptism with joy.

When you are with us for worship, please take a moment to remember your own baptism and ponder your identity as one who has a share of the royal priesthood of Jesus, you who have been marked as Christ's own forever!


2024 Gratitude and Grace

Financial Overview

As suggested in our stewardship writeup, our operating results for the first ten months of 2023 are somewhat better than those assumed in this year's budget. Total Revenues are somewhat higher than projected at \$707.8 thousand, while Total Expenses are somewhat less than expected at \$732.4 thousand. Combining revenues and expenses, our ten month year to date Net Income is a loss of \$24.6 thousand, which compares with a loss of \$46.2 thousand, which was projected last spring. Getting a bit further into the details, reasons for the better than expected performance on Total Revenues, include performance in line with projections for pledge and other contributions from the parish following the usual slowing in such

receipts over the summer and the successful results of this year's auction. Higher than expected dividends on a fund that is part of the endowment was an important positive. Reasons for Total Expenses coming in somewhat lower than forecast include lower than expected expenditures on utilities.

As is usual in this and all years, your help in following through with pledge payments over the next two and a half months is an extremely important component of our plan for the financing of our operations. In this regard, by now, you should have received your Parishioner Pledge Statement which was scheduled for distribution by email or by mail early in October. We learn now that some of these distributions may have been subject to email problems and not delivered as planned.


